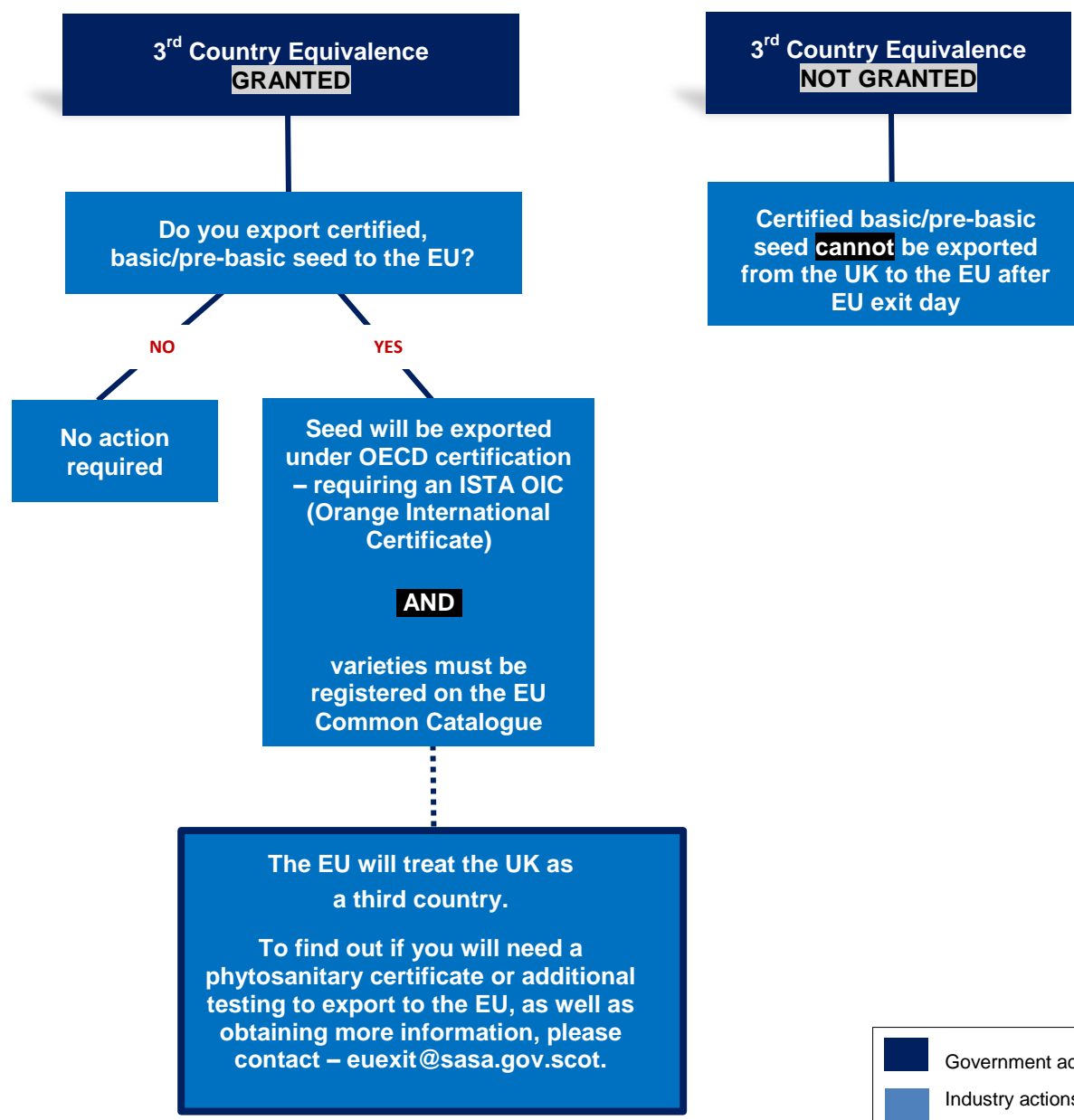


Exporting Certified, basic/pre-basic seed in a 'no deal' exit from the EU

After the UK leaves the EU, the UK Government and Devolved Administrations need to secure 3rd country equivalence with the EU to continue exporting



Importing to the UK from the EU

- The UK will accept EU certified, basic/pre-basic seed and Common Catalogue varieties for a two year interim period – after this period third country rules will apply.
- If the variety previously needed an EU Plant Passport to be imported to the UK from the EU, a phytosanitary certificate will be required.
