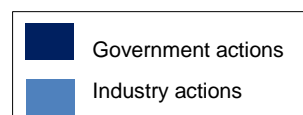
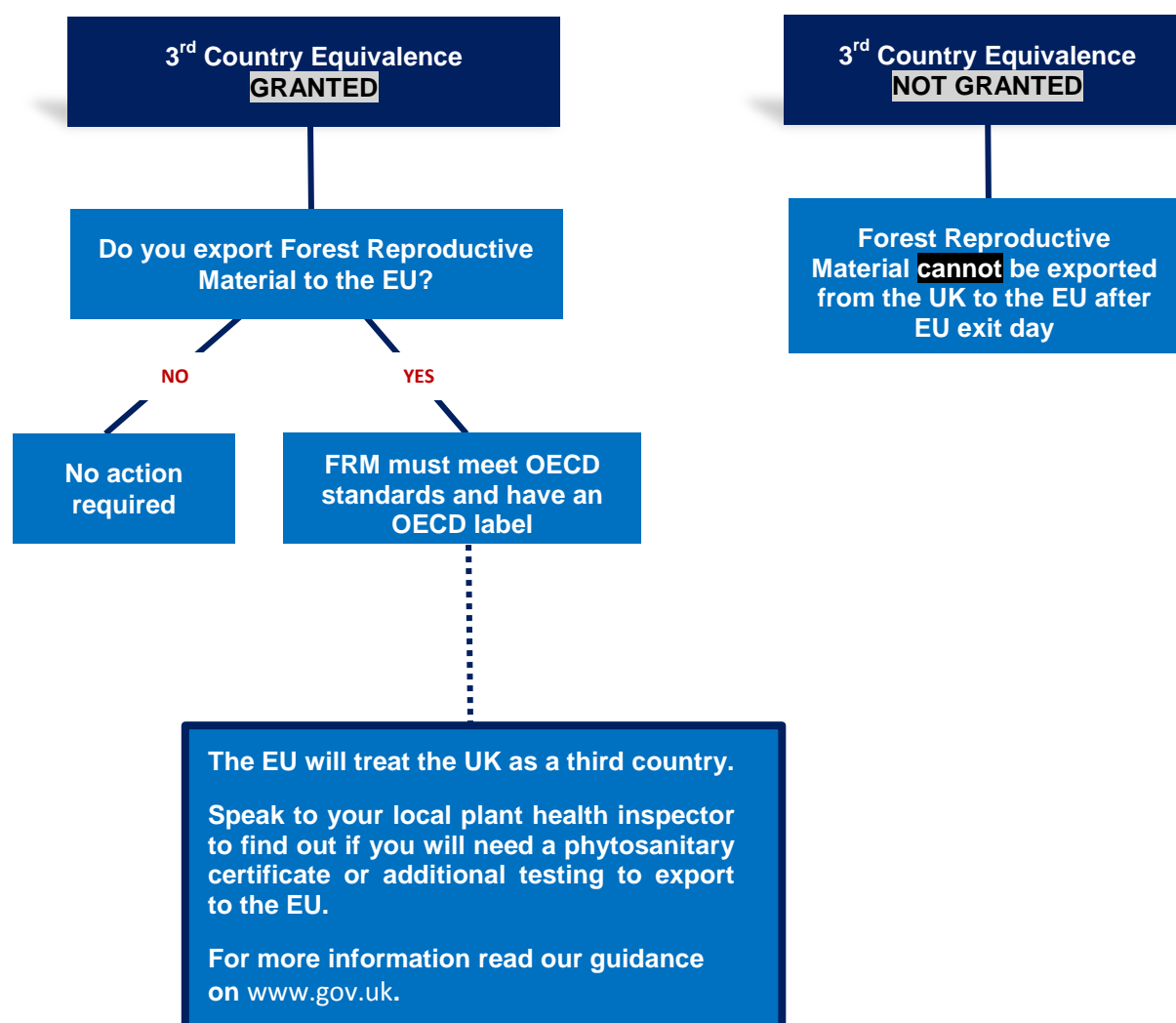


# Exporting FRM (Forest Reproductive Material) in a 'no deal' exit from the EU

After the UK leave the EU, the UK Government and Devolved Administrations need to secure 3<sup>rd</sup> country equivalence with the EU to continue exporting. Scottish Ministers authorise the Forestry Commission to ensure labelling and certification meets OECD requirements.



## Importing to the UK from the EU

- The UK will accept EU FRM (Forest Reproductive Material) will be accepted indefinitely.
- Seed of species managed under the plant passport scheme will require a phytosanitary certificate.
- Other types of propagating material of all species will require a phytosanitary certificate
