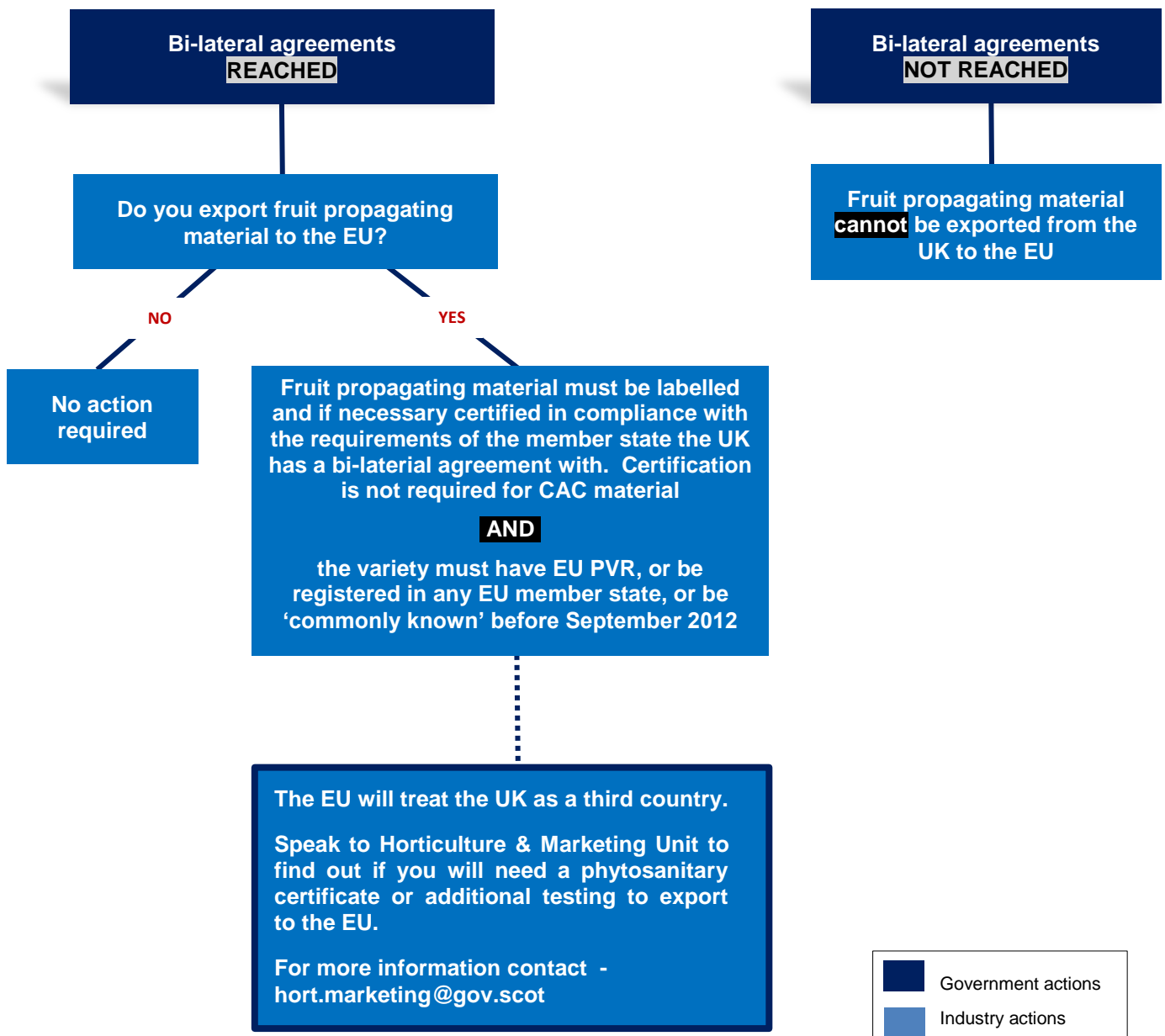


Exporting fruit propagating and planting material in a 'no deal' exit from the EU

After the UK leaves the EU, the UK Government and Devolved Administrations need to reach bi-lateral agreements with EU member states for exporting fruit propagating material



Importing to the UK from the EU

- The UK will accept EU fruit propagating material for a two year interim period – after this period the UK's own third country rules will apply.
- If the plant material previously needed an EU Plant Passport to be imported into the UK from the EU, a phytosanitary certificate will be required.
